How much will it cost?

The buscard costs just £10, so the more you use it, the sooner it pays for itself!

How do I get one?

- Complete the application on the reverse, and return it to us along with two passport photos and a fee of £10. Cheques or Postal Orders should be made payable to Essex County Council. Please do not send cash.
- You must also include valid ID to prove your age: either a photocopied birth certificate or passport. Remember to get your application form and photos signed and stamped either by your Head Teacher/Tutor, employer or, if unemployed, a DSS official. Please ensure that your name and date of birth are written clearly on the back of each photograph.

Conditions of issue and use

- This card is subject to the following conditions and those of the operator.
- The buscard may only be used by the person to whom it has been issued. It is NOT TRANSFERABLE and remains the property of Essex County Council.
- The buscard entitles the holder to the prevailing child rate fares ONLY on the services outlined in this leaflet, whilst those services are available. The Council reserves the right to alter these at any time.
- Reduced fares may only be issued if a valid buscard is shown to the driver at the time the ticket is purchased. Reduced fares will only be valid if the holder can produce a valid buscard to an officer of the County Council or the operator, at any time on the bus.
- The buscard will become invalid if altered, mutilated or defaced, and anyone attempting fraudulent use will be liable to forfeiture of the ticket and prosecution.
- The buscard will expire on the holder reaching their 25th birthday.
- Should the photograph need renewing, this will be done free of charge providing the previous buscard is returned and the new photographs supplied, signed by one of the aforementioned (see previous page).
- Lost and stolen buscards cannot be replaced; a new buscard must be purchased through the usual process.
- Data Protection Act 1998: Information supplied on this form will be held on file and used for the purpose of meeting your request for a buscard.
