How can Telecare help?

Are you worried about a friend or relative on their own?

Telecare can provide 24 hour peace of mind and support. Sensors can monitor a persons home for flood, smoke, carbon monoxide or even remind them to take medication.

At risk of falling?

An alarm can be raised automatically if you fall or you can summon assistance at the press of a button.

Unsure of who is knocking on your door?

The bogus caller button is there to ease concerns about door step callers.
